3 credits of English general education requirement (ENG-102 - Academic Writing and Research 2), 3 credits of Wellness general education requirement, 3-4 credits of Technology Requirement, 3 credits of Social & Behavioral Science general education requirement (other than discipline taken in Term 1), 6-7 credits of Biological & Physical Sciences general education requirement (including one lab), 3 credits of Arts & Humanities general education requirement (other than discipline taken in Term 1), 12 credits from a single discipline, and electives. (Students must take the amount of elective credits to achieve a minimum of 60 credits that are required for this degree.)
